How to pray the Rosary.

*The following prayers are used from the cross to the
centrepiece.*

- 1. Make the Sign of the Cross**
- 2. Say the Apostles' Creed**
- 3. Pray the Our Father on the first bead**
- 4. Pray three Hail Marys on each bead**
- 5. Pray the Glory Be on the fifth bead**
- 6. Announce the First Mystery**

*The following pattern is then used for each
decade.*

- 7. Announce and read the Mystery**
- 8. Pray the Our Father**
- 9. Pray ten Hail Marys on each bead of the
decade**
- 10. Pray the Glory Be on the last bead of the
decade**

*The following prayers are used on the
centrepiece after the final decade has been
prayed.*

- 11. Pray the Hail, Holy Queen**
- 12. Pray the Prayer After the Rosary**

Sign of the Cross
